### SENIORS: START PLANNING FOR THE SAT/ACT

Students applying for colleges/universities need to begin registering for the SAT/ACT. Both the **SAT/ACT** tests measure the skills you have learned in and outside of the classroom and how you can apply that knowledge. The tests are composed of three parts: critical reading, mathematics, and writing.

Nearly every college and university in the U.S. accepts and uses the SAT/ACT as part of its admissions

process, and identifies opportunities for scholarships. Here are the dates:
